Along with the application, you will need provide the following:

- If you are already married, you will need to bring in or mail us your original Certificate of Marriage for in-house review and to copy for our records.
- If you are not yet married, you will need for your clergyperson or officiant to fill out a "To The Trustees of The Smith Charities Certificate of Marriage" form, which is available on our website.

Upon application receipt, 2 written character references are required from non-family members, whose names you are requested to supply on the application. A request form is promptly mailed out from our office to be filled out and sent back to us. It is important that you notify your references right away that a Smith Charities correspondence will be sent to them in order to ensure a prompt written reply. Once received, the application goes to our Trustees for review and possible approval. If approved, we will then mail you the congratulatory beneficiary gift.
