## According to the Will, qualified applicants must:

- Reside in either Amherst, Deerfield, Easthampton, Greenfield, Hadley, Hatfield, Northampton, Whately, or Williamsburg for a minimum of 3 consecutive years before applying.
- Be of good moral character.
- Be of moderate financial circumstances.

After submitting your application and agreement, your program eligibility will be reviewed by our Trustees; in turn, you will receive notification by mail as to their decision. Once a qualified, approved applicant, all that is needed from you is to continue to work and learn in your trade, and to always complete and return the brief, yearly questionnaires. We will send the monetary gift to you when you turn 22 years old after we receive a final verification and letter of recommendation from your supervisor.
